Street Contact - What's involved?

- Complete the self-study Street Contact training provided, or request an online training session via Zoom.
- Once you completed the training, you can create a new email account, e.g. Gmail. For the purpose of sending Intel/information to people in your NSNS street group. For example - hendersondriven@gmail.co.nz
**This is optional you can use your personal email address if you prefer.*
- Encourage your neighbours to join by using the supplied introduction letter or door knock your neighbours. You can even host a street get together.
- New members can complete a Household Joining form, either by paper hard copy or online via our website neighbourhood.org.nz.
- Forward our monthly Intel and newsletter email solely to the members in your group.
- You can start sending these as soon as you have a completed joining form for the household, so please add them to your group mailing list.
- Return all completed membership forms to the NSNS Office, we will then send out their Household Joining Packs directly from our office to them.
- Keep an up to date street group list (Excel sheet or word doc or paper hard copy) and ensure that you let the office know when members change any of their details and if they move away.
- Put NSNS Street Signs up in your street, for any assistance please contact our office.
- Forward on concerns to NSNS office for support and guidance, by email or phone.
