Street Contact - What's involved?

We are hoping to set up more Neighbourhood Support groups in your area, but to do this we need members willing to lead.

The Street Contact's role is to:

- ✓ Oversee a Group of approx. 6-15 neighbours in their street.
- ✓ Be the liaison person between NSNS and the group.
- ✓ Encourage your neighbours to join the group by either,
 - hosting a street get together, or
 - personal introduction through door knocking, or
 - letterbox drops.
- ✓ Forward our monthly crime Intel and newsletter email to the registered members in their group.
- ✓ Inform their group of any issues or reported crime in their street that they have been made aware of.
- ✓ Keep their group's detail as updated annually.
- ✓ Put NSNS Street Signs up in your street, for any assistance please contact our office.
